Please attribute the following response to Greater Dandenong Mayor, Councillor Jim Memeti:

We wholeheartedly welcome today's announcement by the Federal Government that they will match the State Government's \$6.3 million commitment to improve safety on Stud Road, near McFees Road in Dandenong North.

Following a persistent, sustained advocacy campaign we're proud that in one year, this project will be completed for our community.

This important work will reduce the likelihood of further serious accidents on this section of Stud Road, which has a residential neighbourhood on one side, and on the other, Dandenong Stadium, a park, wetlands, bike paths and a bus stop, as well as intersecting freeway ramps.

Today, the Albanese Government is announcing an investment of \$69.7 million in Victorian roads through the Road Safety Program. This investment, in partnership with the Allan Labor Government, will see the delivery of 16 life-saving road safety projects across urban and regional roads in Victoria.

Included in this investment is \$6,301,500 for the intersection at McFees Rd and Stud Rd – full details below.
