On Monday evening, we livestreamed our Council meeting as usual. One of our councillors was attending remotely, which meant we were also running the meeting using Microsoft Teams.

Unfortunately, during the meeting one of our IT officers who was facilitating the meeting received some Teams messages, which then appeared as pop-up alerts in the livestream. One of the messages contained private contact details for a resident.

In order to protect the resident's private information, we took the livestream down as soon as the meeting was over. This meant that anyone watching on delay would have experienced a sudden 'blackout.' We cleaned up the recording of the meeting to remove any Teams messages and we have since published the full recording of the meeting. There was no edit to the audio or the video of the meeting.
