I am writing to raise a concern from a disability housing resident on Cheltenham Rd who claims "Victorian Rentals Melbourne (Dandenong)" has been parking up to 20 cars along Cheltenham Rd, outside of the housing apartments Steven Street entrance of Cheltenham Rd.

The resident raised safety and security risks saying people with mobility and health challenges are housed in the apartments and that it attracts theft and break-ins.

One of the car's plates was stolen according to the resident.

Can the council confirm if there's been multiple complaints about this?

Has the council reached out to this business about the issue?

Would the business need a permit to operate the way it is, parking multiple cars, some unregistered cars on public roads sometimes longer than 90 days?

Is the business operating in line with its permits?

Can the council provide any resolution or relief to the residents in the area against this sort of behaviour?
